



At iResearch Savannah, safety is our top priority. As efforts concerning the containment of COVID-19 (Coronavirus) expand and evolve here in the U.S. and around the world, we want to assure you we are focused on three things:

1. Ensuring the safety of our study volunteers, employees and our community
2. Continuing to provide exceptional service to our study volunteers and sponsors
3. Supporting local efforts to limit the spread and impact of COVID-19

With this in mind, we have determined it is critical we implement new measures to do our part to minimize the spread of COVID-19. **The following are changes effective immediately.**

WHAT TO EXPECT AS A STUDY PARTICIPANT:

- Please **arrive for your appointment 10 minutes early**. A nurse will greet you at the door for a brief **health screening prior to entering the clinic**. This screening will include oral temperature check and a few pertinent questions about your health and your social circle. **If your temperature is above 99.5°F, you may be asked to leave the office** and self-monitor your temperature in the coming days.
- Appointments will now be staggered, and timeframes limited for your visit. This is to minimize the number of people in the office at one time. **If you are late for your appointment, your appointment may need to be rescheduled.**
- We are asking everyone to minimize their use of public transportation (this includes Uber and Lyft). Moving forward, we are significantly reducing the use of Uber. **Please plan to attend your study visits without the use of Uber.** If you are unable to make travel plans on your own, please contact our office.
- **Do not bring additional persons (children, friends, partner/spouse, etc.) to your appointment unless requested to do so by your coordinator.** If other persons arrive with you, they will be asked to leave the office immediately.
- **If you are not feeling well, please reschedule your iResearch appointment and contact your primary care provider.**

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM US:

- **We will continue to be diligent in keeping the office environment clean and sanitized.** You will see us wiping down all surfaces throughout the clinic **after EVERY use**. This includes bathrooms, exam rooms, lounge area (tables & seating).
- **Our staff have committed to not putting themselves at risk** (not going to restaurants, bars, large gatherings) **and are also being screened each day in order to make you, our patients, a priority.**

Currently, we do not anticipate interruption in our clinic schedule. We will continue to communicate as changes are implemented. Please do your part to stay safe and well.
